

Josh Jenkins

Josh Jenkins is a Nashville-based singer-songwriter and lead singer of the band Green River Ordinance. With a songwriting career spanning decades, he's crafted chart-topping hits for some of country music's biggest artists. Josh co-wrote the viral Platinum smash "Fancy Like" with Walker Hayes — a song that reached the Top 5 on the Billboard Hot 100 and became a cultural phenomenon thanks in part to its TikTok breakout and Applebee's campaign. He also co-wrote "Buy Dirt" for Jordan Davis featuring Luke Bryan, which won Song of the Year honors and resonates deeply for its message about family and what matters most. Josh's songs have also been recorded by Dustin Lynch, Randy Houser, Walker Hayes, and many more — and he continues to release solo material showcasing his soulful voice and rich storytelling.



John Ondrasik

Vladimir John Ondrasik III — better known as Five for Fighting — is a platinum-selling, Grammy-nominated singer-songwriter and pianist celebrated for poignant, piano-driven songs that have become part of the modern American songbook. His classics "Superman (It's Not Easy)", "100 Years", and "The Riddle" have collectively earned over one billion streams and remain staples at life's big moments — from graduations to celebrations to quiet reflections. His music has featured in more than 350 films and television shows, and he performed "Superman" at the Concert for New York City after 9/11, honoring first responders and uniting audiences through shared emotion. Beyond performance, Ondrasik champions causes through his work and speaks about creativity, resilience, and the stories behind the songs.



Matt Jenkins

Matt Jenkins is a Texas-born, Nashville-based songwriter with a remarkable track record of hits across country radio. A multi-#1 hitmaker, Matt has penned chart-toppers including "Happy Anywhere" (Blake Shelton ft. Gwen Stefani), "Do I Make You Wanna" (Billy Currington), and "Setting the World on Fire" (Kenny Chesney ft. Pink). His songwriting has also delivered major singles like "Where It's At" (Dustin Lynch) and "Cop Car" (Keith Urban). With more than 50 major label cuts to his credit and collaborations with top artists such as Sam Hunt, Old Dominion, and Jordan Davis, Matt's musical storytelling blends insight, emotion, and broad appeal.



J.T. Harding

J.T. Harding is a versatile American songwriter whose songs have been embraced by some of country music's most prominent artists. He wrote "Smile" for Uncle Kracker, "Somewhere With You" for Kenny Chesney, and "Sangria" for Blake Shelton — all fan favorites that showcase his ability to blend heartfelt emotion with memorable melodies. Born in the U.S., JT's unique journey into music includes influences from rock, pop, and country, giving his work wide appeal across radio formats and audiences.
